


## **Board Meeting Brief**

## STUDENT LEARNING

Board Chair Karpluk voiced the Board's commitment to student learning by ensuring GYPSD students have access to a wide offering of courses and learning platforms goals through HAPARA, and CAMPUS GYPSD.

The Board received a comprehensive report from Assistant Superintendent (acting) Carra Aschenmeier on the review of the <u>Draft K-6 Curriculum.</u> Chair Karpluk stated, "What students learn and how they are supported in their learning is crucial to their success and inclusion within their local communities and their larger society, and their ability to be successful and competitive within the global community. Alberta's education system has regularly scored at the top of the international rankings. And we want to maintain that for our students." The Board was pleased to hear that the Minister of Education has listened to feedback from Albertans.

Chair Karpluk shared the Board's ongoing work to support literacy and <u>numeracy in all of GYPSD's classrooms</u>, and their goal to update the school attendance areas in Edson and Hinton necessary to ensure student enrollment balance exists between the elementary schools in order for program equity.



## TEACHING AND LEADERSHIP EXCELLENCE

The Board shared their appreciation for the teachers on the Curriculum Working Group (CWG) for their deep-dive analysis of the Draft K-6 Curriculum and their research review of studies done by other groups and organizations, like the ATA.

Highlights from <u>Superintendent Lewis' report</u> included:

- HR's commitment to the creation of Administrative Procedure 163 to ensure all GYPSD employees have choice in adhering to the Proof of Vaccine Status or Proof of Negative COVID-19 Rapid Antigen Screening Test (RAST) mandate.

<u>Vice-Chair Shirley Caputo</u> praised the work done by the <u>Alberta</u> School Councils Association (ASCA) in their leadership to support and inform <u>parents and caregivers on councils</u>. She encouraged everyone to attend ASCA's many learning events, and access their website for resources. The Board provides ASCA membership to all GYPSD school councils.



## COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Chair Dale Karpluk invited trustees to identify three key advocacy items to submit to the Rural Caucus of Alberta School Boards (RCASB): Internet connectivity, Transportation, and timely access to community Mental Health supports were named. The RCASB represents the voice of 41 rural boards in Alberta who collectively advocate to the Minister of Education and the Premier to support excellence in rural education.
