VISION

Essential Conditions

• Division engages in conversation building shared beliefs including an understanding of speech development and how it affects a student's ability to communicate effectively and how it impacts their ability to learn in the school environment.

ACTION

The Speech-Language Pathologist (SLP) will:

• Provide ongoing information and education about speech sound development to the school staff.

SUCCESS

Indicators

- Speech referrals are appropriate and outline specific speech language needs.
- Teachers can state how they support speech language development in their classroom.

LEADERSHIP

Essential Conditions

- SLP will work with school staff to understand and be able to identify students requiring speech therapy intervention:
 - To have the staff have a good understanding of speech development; and
 - Collaborate with school staff to assist in making appropriate speech referrals.

ACTION

The Speech-Language Pathologist (SLP) will:

 Provide a developmental checklist to school staff to assist in determining if students should be referred for speech assessments.

SUCCESS

Indicators

• Number of appropriate referrals (specific and meeting speech criteria as outlined on the referral info sheet).

RESEARCH AND EVIDENCE

Essential Conditions

- Research: Development of a speech guideline checklist.
- Evidence: Number of appropriate referrals.

ACTION

The Speech-Language Pathologist (SLP) will:

- Keep up to date regarding the newest research about speech and phonological development; and
- Provide strategies to teachers to use in classrooms to assist students in the learning environment (E.g. modelling).

SUCCESS

Indicators

• Decrease in inappropriate speech referrals.

Essential Conditions

• Development of a speech guideline checklist.

ACTION

The Speech-Language Pathologist (SLP) will:

- Keep up to date on the newest research of speech development;
- Collaborate with LST's and teachers to assist school staff in determining who should be referred for a speech assessment and therapy;
- To collaborate with LST's for *Gradual Release of Responsibility* that allows teachers to build confidence in determining if students require a speech referral; and
- Provide teachers with strategies to use in the classroom to assist speech development within the classroom environment.

SUCCESS

Indicators

• Feedback from teachers being more confident in their ability to make appropriate speech referrals.

PROFESSIONAL GROWTH

Essential Conditions

• SLP will collaborate with LST's and learning services team members to understand the checklist.

ACTION

The Speech-Language Pathologist (SLP) will:

- Use the most up to date speech developmental information for teachers to use a developmental speech reference; and
- SLP will discuss with the LST's about speech referrals as they arise throughout the school year.

SUCCESS

Indicators

• Speech referrals have speech development information on the referral from.

Essential Conditions

• LST meetings.

ACTION

The Speech-Language Pathologist (SLP) will:

- Review and check for understanding of the developmental checklist; and
- SLP will visit each school at least once a month to support staff in schools and respond to specific questions via email and or one to one regarding speech development support and for students within the classroom.

Indicators

• SLP shared information at LST meetings.
