

STUDENT COUNCIL/STUDENT LEADERSHIP GROUPS

Background

Participation in a Student Council/Student Leadership group provides students the opportunity to engage in socially responsible activities such as leadership, philanthropy and volunteerism. The Division, therefore, encourages the formation of Student Council/Student Leadership groups in schools.

Procedures

- 1. The principal has final authority over all Student Council/Student Leadership group activities.
- 2. Student Council/Student Leadership group must operate within the framework of acceptable financial practices.
 - 2.1 An annual Student Council/Student Leadership group financial statement will be filed with the principal.
 - 2.2 The principal will report Student Council/Student Leadership group fund activities as part of the annual report required under Administrative Procedure 520 School Fundraising.
- 3. Appropriate teacher guidance will be provided to Student Council/Student Leadership group.
 - 3.1 One (1) or more teachers will be appointed as Student Council/Student Leadership group advisors.
