

SCHOOL BUS OPERATOR CREDENTIALS

Background

The Division believes that a safe student transportation system requires qualified and safety oriented school bus operators.

Procedures

- 1. The minimum credentials for School Bus Operators in the Division will be identified by the Director of Transportation Services.
 - 1.1 All Bus Operators in the Division will be approved by Transportation Services.
 - 1.2 Division Operator Requirements:
 - 1.2.1 a valid Class 1 or Class 2 Alberta Operator's License; with an "S" Endorsement.
 - 1.2.2 The driver of a Multi-Function Activity Bus (MFAB) with a seating capacity of 24 passengers or less must have a valid Class 1, 2 or 4 Alberta Operator's Licence with an "S" Endorsement
 - 1.2.3 valid First Aid Certificate; and
 - 1.2.4 Alberta Driver's abstract indicating that the operator has fewer than six (6) demerit points.
 - 1.3 Transportation Services may require that an operator attend a defensive driving course for any of the following:
 - an at fault collision,
 - accumulation of demerit points,
 - driving errors,
 - traffic violation, or
 - at the discretion of the Director of Transportation Services
- 2. Regular upgrading and training programs will be provided for Division Bus Operators to ensure high skill levels and safety awareness.
 - 2.1 Transportation Services will arrange for regular offerings of the courses required to enhance skills and knowledge or to maintain regulatory compliance
 - 2.2 Completion of the assigned coursework within the set due dates is mandatory.
 - 2.3 Disciplinary action may be taken for any non-compliance up to and including removal from active service.
