

School Bus Rider Rules

- 1. Students should be waiting at the bus stop 3–5 minutes before scheduled pickup time and be appropriately dressed for weather conditions.
- 2. If you have to cross the road to board the bus, wait until traffic is clear, and the bus driver signals you to do so.
- **3.** Students are to go directly to the seat assigned to them and sit facing forward with their feet in front of them.
- **4.** Students must keep all body parts and items inside the bus. Place all garbage in the trash container.
- 5. Riders need to stay seated at all times while the bus is moving.
- 6. Talk quietly to avoid distracting the bus driver.
- 7. Only bring what can be held on your lap or safely stored under the seat of the bus. Check with the bus driver before taking sports equipment or band equipment on the bus.
- 8. Follow the directions of the bus driver at all times.
- **9.** Profanity, abusive language/behavior or possession/use of drugs, tobacco or alcohol, on the school bus, will not be permitted. Incidents will be reported to the Principal immediately.
