New Principal Announcement Niton Central School

Immediate Release: August 18, 2022 - Grande Yellowhead Public School Division (GYPSD) is pleased to announce that Mr. Steven Ripkens has accepted the position of Principal for Niton Central School beginning the 2022/2023 school year.

Mr. Ripkens was previously a Learning Services Supervisor at central office, but had been assigned as Acting Principal for Niton Central for the second half of the 2021/2022 school year. In 2018, he moved to Edson with his wife and two sons for the position of Assistant Principal at Parkland Composite High School. He also was the Assistant Principal at Niton Central for the 2019/2020 school year.
