
MOUNTAIN PARK LODGES HEALTHCARE SCHOLARSHIP

Background

In memory of the original founders, the Board of Directors of Mountain Park Lodges have established this scholarship fund to be used for students from the Jasper Junior/Senior High School who are registered in a post-secondary institution for study or training related to a career in physical, mental or social care.

The scholarship funds are held in trust by Grande Yellowhead Public School Division.

Funding

1. Each year's scholarship award shall be derived from the interest earned in the previous year on the initial investment of \$5,000.
2. The scholarship shall not be less than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) in any year in which it is awarded.
3. Any unpaid interest will be reinvested and added to the principal.
4. Grande Yellowhead Public School Division shall administer the fund by investing in guaranteed securities or in a savings account that has an interest rate that is higher than guaranteed securities.
5. The scholarship shall cease to exist once contributions have been exhausted.
6. Payment of the scholarship will be made on receipt of verification of the successful applicant's acceptance at a post-secondary institution in the program(s) related to the scholarship.
7. Advertising for the scholarship will take place during August and September of each year.

Nature of the Award

The Mountain Park Lodges Healthcare Scholarship will consist of a certificate and an award of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).

Eligibility Criteria and Selection

The recipient of the scholarship will be identified by the Jasper Junior/Senior High School Awards' Committee. Upon selection of the recipient, the Awards' Chair shall provide written notification to the Office of the Superintendent. The award will be presented to the student at the annual Jasper Junior/Senior High School Awards' Night.

The individual who is selected shall satisfy the following criteria:

1. Have attended Jasper Junior/Senior High School in Jasper, Alberta in their last year of secondary schooling; and
2. Be registered in a post-secondary institution for study or training related to a career in physical, mental or social care; and

3. Submit an application by October 1 to the Jasper Junior/Senior High School Awards' Committee accompanied by a written copy of acceptance to a post-secondary course in hospitality or business, and a copy of the applicant's marks in their most recent academic year; and
4. Not have been a previous recipient of this scholarship.

Preference will be given to students entering studies related to a career in physical, mental or social care.

Award

The amount of the award will be determined by the amount of interest earned in that year, and will be a minimum scholarship of five hundred dollars (\$500.00).
