Procedures

- 1. Membership (as defined in the CUPE Collective Agreement)
 - One (1) representative from Administration.
 - Two (2) representatives each from ATA and CUPE.
- 2. Decision Making
 - The Committee has the power to make recommendations to the Union and the Administration with respect to its discussions and conclusions.
- 3. Quorum
 - All representatives.
- 4. Minutes
 - Kept and circulated to Committee members.
- 5. Reporting
 - To the Board in writing and submitted as information only.
